

PUBLIC HEARING FOR ROAD

This Public Hearing was held on this 16th day of April 2013 at the Hays Mallory Community Building, 216 Crane Street, Edwardsville, Illinois to hear the Tentative budget and appropriation ordinance for the Road District of the Township of Edwardsville, County of Madison, State of Illinois, as prepared by Highway Commissioner Hal Henschen, for the Fiscal Year of April 1, 2013 and ending March 31, 2014.

Chairman Campbell asked the Town Clerk to read the minutes of the Public Hearing held April 10, 2012 for Tentative Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Town purposes for fiscal year 2012-2013 as prepared by Highway Commissioner Hessel.

Chairman Campbell asked for a motion to approve the minutes as read. Motion by Highway Commissioner Henschen and seconded by Trustee Picarella to approve minutes as read. Voting "Yes" 19 Voting "No" 0. Motion Passed.

Chairman Campbell announced the Tentative Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the Road District of Edwardsville Township for the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 has been accepted by the Town Board of Trustees for posting for Public Inspection at their regular meeting of March 26, 2013 and was posted at the Supervisors Office, 300 West Park Street, Edwardsville, Illinois, as of March 27, 2013.

Chairman Campbell asked if there was any discussion on the Road District Budget for the fiscal year 2013-2014. Chairman Campbell asked for a Motion by a member of the Town Board of Trustees to approve the Road District Budget for the fiscal year 2013-2014. Motion by Trustee Krumeich and seconded by Trustee Miles to approve the Road Budget for the fiscal year 2013-2014. The Chairman then asked the Town Clerk for a roll call vote of the Town Board. Voting "Yes" were Trustees Krumeich, Picarella, Williamson, Miles and Supervisor Campbell. Motion Passed.
