

## Edwardsville Township Meeting Minutes

June 27, 2013

The meeting of Edwardsville Township was called to order by Supervisor Miles at 7:00 p.m.

Trustee Kennett led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Supervisor Miles asked Clerk Schulte to call the roll. Present were Supervisor Miles, Trustees Krumeich, Picarella, Kennett, Head, Assessor Klopmeier, Highway Commissioner Henschen and Clerk Schulte.

Motion to approve the minutes of the May 28, 2013 meeting made by Trustee Head and seconded by Trustee Picarella. Motion Passed. Voting "Yes" were Trustees Krumeich, Picarella, Kennett, Head and Supervisor Miles.

Motion to approve the expenditures of the Township and Highway funds for the month of May 25, 2013 thru June 25, 2013 made by Trustee Krumeich and seconded by Trustee Picarella. Motion Passed. Voting "Yes" were Trustees Krumeich, Picarella, Kennett, Head and Supervisor Miles.

Supervisor Miles commended Highway Commissioner Henschen and the Highway Department on the storm clean-up of the Highways and working with the City of Edwardsville.

Supervisor Miles reported that the Township audit will begin July 15, 2013

Supervisor Miles reported the Junior Service Boundless Playground is complete.

Trustee Picarella reported traffic congestion at the Park and has installed temporary stop signs and cross walks.

Supervisor Miles reported the Edwardsville Rotary will be at the July meeting to update the Board on the Rotary Playground scheduled to start work in September.

Supervisor Miles has talked to Lewis & Clark Community College about a Grant to change the restroom at the Park, by the playgrounds, to solar thermal heated year round.

Supervisor Miles is talking to Leah Dettmers about a grant for bike racks at the park.

Trustee Krumeich submitted a report on the needs of the Hays Mallory Community Building and the Township Office. Report on file.

Trustee Head is our new liaison to the Main Street Community Center.

Trustee Kennett assisted with getting the Electric Aggregation effort up to speed in the Township and all the paper work is finalized. Trustee Kennett checked with the Edwardsville/Glen Carbon Chamber of Commerce about the Township joining the Chamber. The cost would be \$167.00 thru 2014.

Supervisor Miles is meeting with the Glen-Ed food Pantry and the Ministerial Alliance to review our General Assistance Program. One issue is the development of a work program for those receiving assistance.
