

Edwardsville Township Meeting Minutes

September 25, 2012

The meeting of Edwardsville Township was called to order by Supervisor Campbell at 7:00 p.m. Present were Supervisor Campbell, Trustees Krumeich, Picarella, Williamson, Miles, Assessor Klopmeier, Highway Commissioner Henschen and Clerk Schulte.

Trustee Picarella led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the August 28, 2012 meeting made by Trustee Krumeich and seconded by Trustee Williamson. Motion Passed.

Motion to approve the expenditures of Supervisor Campbell and Highway Commissioner Henschen made by Trustee Miles and seconded by Trustee Picarella. Motion Passed. Voting "Yes" were Trustees Krumeich, Picarella, Williamson, Miles and Supervisor Campbell.

Elizabeth Heil and Steve Langendorf of Scheffel & Co. presented the Edwardsville Township Audit Report and Financial Statement for the year ending March 31, 2012. The Auditor gave Edwardsville Township a "clean opinion". Motion to approve Auditor's report made by Trustee Miles and seconded by Trustee Krumeich. Motion Passed. Voting "Yes" were Trustees Krumeich, Picarella, Williamson, Miles and Supervisor Campbell.

Trustee Miles reported he talked to Mr. John Gibbons, from the Edwardsville Rotary. The Edwardsville Rotary has appointed three committees, the Funding, Design and Building and Public Relations, to address the purposed rebuilding of the children's playground at the Township Park.


Motion to enter Executive Session for the purpose of personal issues made by Trustee Williamson and seconded by Trustee Krumeich. Motion Passed.

Trustee Williamson asked Assessor Klopmeier why the County assessed a garage in Edwardsville Township. Assessor Klopmeier said she would check if she gets an address.

Trustee Williamson asked Highway Commissioner Henschen, what portion of the Highway Department roads were rock and chip and what portion concrete. Highway Commissioner Henschen said approximately 10% concrete, 10% asphalt, 80% rock and chip.
