

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-R10

AUTHORIZING EDWARDSVILLE TOWNSHIP TO ADOPT A FAIR HOUSING RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Edwardsville Township of Madison County, Illinois, finds that the economic stability of the Township directly depends upon stable, integrated, and balanced patterns; and

WHEREAS, it further finds that stable and integrated and balanced living patterns are threatened by discriminatory acts and unlawful housing practices; and

WHEREAS, it further finds that discriminatory acts and unlawful housing practices contribute to the formation and preservation of segregated neighborhoods, thereby affecting the quality of daily life of the citizens of the Township; and

WHEREAS, it further finds that discriminatory acts and unlawful housing practices interfere with the achievement of stable, integrated and balanced living patterns, thereby depriving the citizens of the benefits of interracial interreligious and intercultural association.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Supervisor and the Board of Trustees of Edwardsville Township as follows:


1. That the findings hereinabove stated are hereby incorporated by reference and made a part of Resolution.
2. The discriminatory and unlawful housing practices as defined by the Department of Housing and Urban Development pursuant to the Community Block Grant Regulations, are hereby specifically against the policy and practices of Edwardsville Township to participate in or allow the expenditure of government funds for housing projects which are not consistent with HUD rules and regulations.

Motion was made by Trustee Hall, seconded by Trustee Schmidt
that the Resolution be adopted and approved by Five (5) Ayes and Zero (0) Nays.
