SUPERVISORS COMMENTS:

- Touch-A-Truck we couldn't have asked for better weather, I felt like the event was well received and haven't received any issues. We had a COVID vaccine clinic as part of it, but are still awaiting the number of vaccines given. We received a lot of food and diaper donations to provide to the community. And we raised over \$19,000 with around \$4,000 in expenses from the event.
- LiHeap (September 1 - October 31) numbers we assisted 145 residents.
- Benefit Access (Jan 1 - October 31) numbers we assisted 120 residents
- Sexual harassment training we will get out in the beginning of November to try and get all completed by mid - December.
- Illinois Senior Farmer's Market Vouchers: The state ended the program for 2021 last week, Christine and the staff did a great job distributing 90 vouchers in total and returned 10 from the office to the State.
- Building Update - I did check with First-Mid to make sure waiting till 2022 wouldn't cause any issue, and they said it would not cause a problem. Our Audits were filed with the County Clerk's office & state comptroller.
- Finally, you may have noticed in your packets a list of our quarterly financial breakdown of the Highway Department CDs. Due to the low interest rates, we have been reinvesting them in shorter CDs in hopes rates will rise.

- All Assessor employees are vaccinated for Covid-19 per Township Policy.
- We have started the 2021 Board Hearings. We currently have 100 appeals. In 2020 we had 76, so for a quad year that is nice amount.
- We have hired a New Construction Data Collector, Aaron King. He started October 18th.


